LETTER SENT TO THE RESIDENCE ASSOCIATION WITH THE RESIDENTS OBJECTIONS

For the attention of The Residence Association

Please find enclosed letters from the residents of Craig Penllyn with their comments (I have retained copies).

As you can see the main concerns are from the residents who live near the proposed project. *(I note that the residence association committee members do not live in close proximity to the proposed project)*. I feel most concerned that Winchfield house will be surrounded by these tarmac roads, Mrs Morecroft has been one of the longest residents in this village for 43 years, and I feel you have been particularly thoughtless to her in regards to the Winchfield Project.

Would you like these roads around your property?

I'm sure the answer would be NO.

The Association was set up originally to protect people from this kind of development, from some of the comments in these letters suggested that the meeting you had to discuss this development was less than satisfactory. A new meeting should be convened to discuss the plan with the residents, and to come to a satisfactory outcome. Please let me know when the next Residence Association meeting is to take place, and can I suggest we **only** discuss the Winchfield Project.

My personal views and that of other residents are to keep Craig Penllyn special and cancel the ill conceived and badly planned project.

I would appreciate some answers to my questions prior to any meeting regarding the Winchfield Project.
