Dear Mr Reade,

Thank you for your letter of the 11<sup>th</sup> October 2009 outlining your reasons and request for an EGM. As you are aware, the Chair, Barbara Whitehouse is currently out of the country and I am responding in her absence.

I am aware that Barbara has been in contact with you over this matter and we all take your concerns very seriously. Indeed, in response to your original letter of the August 2009, supported by other residents concerns, we felt it was important to re-convey the complete picture of the proposals across the community and we issued a letter on the 1<sup>st</sup> of October inviting all members of the community to formally respond to us if they still had concerns by October 31<sup>st</sup>. We intend to collate and consider these and any other relevant information before taking any further action. In light of the specific nature of the proposed motions within your letter, we feel that it would not be appropriate to go ahead with an EGM until Barbara is able to attend and would therefore look to set the date for this on her return in November.

In the interim having discussed this with other members on the Residents Association Committee it would be helpful to meet with you to listen to your concerns first hand and to discuss ways forward. Myself, Colin Parsons and Sarah Medlecott would like to meet with you and others as appropriate on Monday the 26<sup>th</sup> October at 8 pm in the Barley Mow.

We hope that it will be possible to find an amicable resolution to the concerns you raise that will help meet the needs of the community as a whole.

If this is not convenient please could you suggest some alternative dates .
