**Call for Extra Ordinary General Meeting (EGM)**

Thank you for your letter of 16 October 2009 in response to the letter of 11 October 2009 calling for an EGM.

In replying to your letter and the suggestions you make, I believe it would be helpful if I clarify my own position. Whilst I have been prepared to coordinate the opposition in Graig Penllyn to the proposed cycle track, I do not seek to represent the views of others and it would be wrong of me to do so. By the letter of 11 October a large number of residents have requested an EGM so that they can present their own views and then vote on the various motions. I suggest that this is correct way to take the matter forward at this stage. I must therefore decline your suggestion of an informal meeting with me before the EGM.

I fully understand the Committee's reluctance to hold the EGM in the Chair's absence and I would have no objection to deferring the meeting until her return. However, I must stress that this is my personal view and others may think differently. If you decide to delay until November, may I suggest that you consider extending the deadline for comments until the date of the EGM. My sense is that residents would prefer to raise their concerns at the EGM rather than set them out in writing beforehand.

As before I have posted a copy of this letter on the Graig notice board for information.
